Interactive Map for Victoria's Container Deposit Scheme Now Live

Victorians wanting to cash in their containers when the state's Container Deposit Scheme (CDS Vic) starts on 1 November can now find the closest refund point to them.

An interactive map revealing the locations of refund points ready to open next Wednesday is now live at cdsvic.org.au

Hundreds of refund points are ready to open across Victoria, and more will open in the coming weeks. By August 2024 the network will grow to more than 600 refund points.

CDS Vic will reward Victorians with a 10 cent refund for every eligible can, carton and bottle they return.

To determine if a container is eligible for a refund, check for the 10 cent mark.
